ACCEPTANCE OF MINUTES

Resolution to Approve Minutes of Meetings

A motion was made and seconded to approve the Board of Trustee minutes dated March 30, 2022. The motion was unanimously approved to accept the minutes as presented.

President Daigler provided updates on legislative activity, Free College Initiative, Nursing Expansion and the Advancement of Maine's Workforce initiatives. President Daigler recommended two candidates to the board of trustees during the executive session.

A motion was made and seconded to authorize the MCCS President to extend an offer of employment to the candidate for the Presidency at Eastern Maine Community College, and come to an agreement on the reasonable and customary terms and conditions of employment
