Integration to accept payments in this platform from students and employers on behalf of a student cohort is needed. - Anthology is currently in the deep dive (discovery) stage of the implementation, and no build has started at this time. MCCS's goal is to unify payment systems across all colleges and exchange payment information with Anthology, which will also have the Faculty management, contracts and administration; Data visualization, reports, and analytics; Position control and budgeting; Faculty and program ROI; Human capital management.
